

Important topics for living in Germany, for example:

1. Migration and Foreignness: How do norms and values differ between different cultures? What is unusual for us in Germany?
2. Life in a Social and Constitutional State: What types of social programs are available? How can I make provisions for my old age? What are my responsibilities in daily life?
3. Childhood and Upbringing: What kind of norms and values are there in education? What do I have to know about education in daycare and school?
4. Education and Profession: What possibilities do I have to educate myself and what options are available to me?
5. Health Care and Ageing: What can I do to keep myself healthy? What type of help is available if someone becomes ill or needs care?
6. Equal Rights - Equal Opportunities: What are the roles of men and women in Germany? What opportunities exist for people with disabilities?

- Radio Coworkers: Work at LOHRO radio station: prepare broadcasts, write texts, conduct interviews, work with computers.
- Parent Organizers: Meet with other parents to talk about children, child rearing, daycare and school, exchange experiences, discuss problems.
- You can develop your interests and use your talents! You will have contact with Germans and your activities will be supported by our project.

Plan an evening program: The community of Rostock will learn something about your native country. For example, you could prepare a presentation about your home country and tell others something about its culture, history, politics or geography. Or perhaps you would like to sing, dance and cook with the locals!

The class will be offered in your vicinity. It is free and travel costs may be reimbursed.
